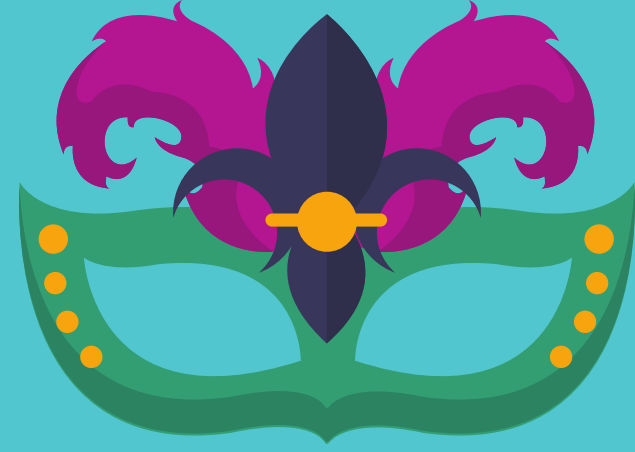


HAPPY PURIM!
